Small semi. No cars about. Ran about playing football and cricket.</p> <p>At aged 11 passed 11 plus and went to Leeds Central High School. Moved to Gledhow Wood Ave. Roundhay Park was his playground.</p> <p>Aged 13 did paper round for Mr and Mrs Parkin in Oakwood. 9s 6d a week for 5 nights. Lot of fun but hard work on a Friday night because of heavier papers. Comic night. Fave record Del Shannon, Runaway.</p> <p>Went down to shops. Promoted to head lad. Delivered round to shops and would have to cover for lads who didn't turn up.</p> <p>Butchers, bakers, greengrocers, Post Office, library had been a police station. Barkers of Oakwood sold cars, phone number 656565.</p> <p>A good time – raced around Roundhay Park like lunatics. Went to Harehills Junior School on Roundhay Road. Mother used to take him into Lewis' in town. Loads of kids to play with.</p> <p>Went to Youth Club from 13 / 14. Methodist on North Park Ave, then Congo, Congregational, then St Edmunds. All played music.</p> <p>Worked in Leeds on Vicar Lane. Went up to Mecca on Arcade to go dancing at lunchtime. If they found a girl would go to Roundhay Park. Would go to Mecca again at night time.</p> <p>Had 2 aunties living with them and a family dog called Pluto.</p> <p>Children's Day in Roundhay Park. Hill 60 really busy. Wonders why it packed up because it could unite a lot of people. Had fair in park, was great. Teddy Boys.</p> <p>Used to have boats out on lake. On top lake had little fella called Norman with half mast trousers and a Woodbine. Always remember him. Had rowing there as well as bottom lake.</p> <p>Bottom of lake had an outdoor pool. It was full. White House Pub was a private family house then.</p> <p>Went down North Lane to deliver papers. Used to thunder about on bikes.</p> <p>Used to meet at Clock. Always in good condition then, but not paved. Trams went up there. Caught trams from school – would throw stuff out of windows. Went up for Sports Day once a year.</p>
