4.30	<p>Lives on Oakwell Mount. Aged 9. Born in America then lived on Oakwood Walk. Has twin brother and a younger brother. Goes to Roundhay St John's Primary School. Goes by car. Mum is a teacher. Uniform – red jumper, white shirt, skirts or pinafores or trousers. Prefers trousers. Has a PE kit. Plays games at school.</p> <p>Has worship in the morning, then guided reading, more worship, maths, then goes outside, literacy, lunch, lessons in afternoon. Classroom – has rows of 4 people. Lots of things on the walls. Likes art and writing stories, mysteries. Has school dinners – can choose what they want to eat. Favourite is chicken korma.</p> <p>Trips – to Magna in Year 3. It's going to be refurbished.</p> <p>Emma goes to the cinema on Kirkstall Road. At weekends she likes to play in the garden, make things and do baking.</p>
10.30	<p>Grannies and Grandads are not local. She goes to friends' houses to play.</p> <p>Likes going to school – it's fun. Has a new teacher. In Year 3 walked through Oakwood up to school. Will go on to Roundhay School because she can walk there.</p>
12.00	<p>Goes to ballet on Mondays and Brownies, at Oakwood Church.</p>
13.00	<p>Does sewing on a proper sewing machine. Made skirt and a furry cushion. Makes teddy bears. Made a Tudor kitchen for school.</p>
14.45	<p>At Christmas have performances at school and Christmas activities. Had a Christmas jumper day.</p> <p>Tour de France 2014 – had a bike race on Sports Day. Raced on school field on a track. Will do cycling proficiency badge in Year 6. Pancake Pandemonium – have races then have pancakes in the hall. School walks to school for Harvest and Christmas. Year 6s get awarded a Bible.</p>
