1.30	<p>Born in Leeds in the Hyde Park area in 1953. Lived in Oakwood for 19 years and in Street Lane area for a bit longer than that. Parents were refugees from Estonia – they had no car and lived in the Hyde Park area so came to Roundhay Park on a day trip by tram.</p> <p>Remembers being on the tram.</p> <p>During roadworks on the Roundhay Road she saw the old tram lines. Drove around tram park during driving lessons.</p>
2.45	<p>Came up for Children’s Day. Mother had to make a mustard coloured dress for it.</p> <p>Danced there with school and was May Queen for the school.</p> <p>Went to the park with her own children.</p> <p>Shops – a haberdasher, green grocers, a cobblers, glassware, cutlery, and a hairdressers. All changed now.</p>
