1. Giving by Standing Order

Regular giving through a STANDING ORDER helps the Joint Church Council here at Oakwood Church budget effectively and support the great work done by our church, the Circuit and the Diocese.

You can set up a standing order easily online, or by telephoning your bank. More traditionally it can be done by writing to the local branch of your bank or building society.

To set up a standing order to Oakwood Church you should send your regular donation to the following bank account, which is the account we use to receive money that is shared between the Methodist and Church of England finances but has to be held by one of the two legal trust bodies – in this case the Methodist one:

As we are a joint church, we are encouraging everyone to consider giving regularly to Oakwood Church. The money Oakwood Church receives is used directly for the outreach and mission of Oakwood Church. Any money left at the end of the year is shared between the Methodist and Anglican structures that make up our congregation, to meet the continued obligations of both.

If you would prefer to make your regular gift to just the Methodist or the Anglican structure directly, then you can start (or continue) to do this via the envelopes, but preferably by standing order.
