2.30	<p>9th North Leeds Scout Group. Jack, Harry, Sam, Charlie, Cale, Caden, Lamty (Laurence)</p> <p>Jack – started Scouts aged 10 or 11. Aged 12 now. Likes reading, drawing, history, Pokemon. At Scouts likes going on camps, local history. Likes people at Scouts. At camp, goes to Wyke, put up tents, meals and activities in hut.</p>
4.00	<p>Harry – likes activities and people. Not keen on camp. Very new to Scouts.</p> <p>Sam – does something new every week at Scouts</p> <p>Charlie – does grass sledging in park. Likes going on camps. Has to wear a helmet because you can crash into trees! Goes down Hill 60.</p>
5.30	<p>Cale –only just joined. Likes going bowling. Good conversation. Will want to camp.</p> <p>Caden – likes bowling, camps, grass sledging.</p> <p>Lamty – 3 favourite things, ice skating, grass sledging and camp. Likes map reading and survival. How to make knots. Put up own tents. Singsong in evenings.</p>
9.05	<p>Survival – Charlie – you make your own barbecue. You gather wood and make a fire and put metal grill on top and then put food on. Cheat by using matches.</p> <p>Lamty – for breakfast have eggs, bacon, sausages, baked beans at camp. Sometimes eat outside.</p> <p>Jack – for lunch it varies a lot.</p> <p>Charlie – what Wyke is like – small country lane, narrow, has a beck at the bottom and has a few bridges and a chapel. Top of hill – set up tents, camp fire, flag pole. Go for a weekend. Often quite wet.</p>
10.35	<p>Cale – Roundhay Park – Maze Run. Day before Halloween. Found clues and went round the woods in the dark.</p>
12.35	<p>Charlie – night hike – go round and follow trail which can be hard.</p> <p>Geo-caching – something is hidden and GPS shows you where to go. Like a treasure hunt. Find a plastic box and you can trade the things in the box.</p>
14.20	<p>Charlie – a world wide activity. You plug GPS into computer. Do 6 Dales – get up at 2am and walk entire day. Really tiring. Can just do some stages of the walk if you want.</p> <p>Jack – arrive for Scouts at 8pm and leave at 9-9.15pm. Camp Friday to Sunday.</p> <p>Jack – enjoys camp and meeting other Scout groups.</p> <p>Charlie – at Wyke we went to beck where there is clay and made little bowls out of it and dried them by campfire.</p> <p>Cale –likes bowling. Likes canoeing at camp, on lake.</p> <p>Caden – 3 in a boat. Wore life vests and helmets.</p> <p>Lamty – ice skating.</p>
17.30	<p>Oakwood – what do you do when you are not at Scouts?</p> <p>Lamty – watch TV or go on laptop</p> <p>Caden – goes on Wii, reads, lego. Walk to school past the clock every day.</p>
20.45	<p>Cale – likes bushcraft and fishing. Foraging. Making a bow saw.</p> <p>Charlie – quite often goes to Post Office in Oakwood and sweet shop. Nice café there. 3 supermarkets.</p> <p>Sam – plays with friends on street – bike rides to Oakwood to get milkshakes and go in woods with bikes.</p> <p>Harry – takes dogs out, plays in woods.</p>

<p>Jack – reads, draws, Pokemon. Every Sat there is an Oakwood market – nice people there. Charlie – in market they do nice venison burgers!</p> <p>How will Oakwood have changed in 100 years time? Caden – will be high tech. Flying cars, hover boards. Harry – where clock is there could be a museum there for cars and stuff. Sam – might have massive skyscrapers and space ships. Lamty – shops might have gone. Big museum the height of the clock in the centre. Charlie – might be some shops but will be housing estates everywhere. Cale – food won't be nice, rations. Loads of new tech. New sciences – travel at speed of light. Colonising other planets. Jack – roads might be solar panelled. Lamty – future humans might be in a battle. Charlie – Oakwood might be a battleground, riots. Cale – might not be a future. Hopefully they will dig capsule up and listen to us.</p>
